- Work to begin in July on converting our permit system from Accela PermitsPlus to Accela Automation, including their AccelaGIS component
- The GIS Office will be moving to "open (free) data" for parcels, topo, etc in July
- FEMA flood mapping revision back in-progress after funding restored
- Assisted local environmental health dept with install and provided data for their ArcGIS
- Assisted Hagerstown Community College in mapping major facilities
- Developed interactive web map for local Election Board polling places
- Working with Washington County Public Schools to develop interactive web map showing school attendance zones
- Working with Washington County Department of Water Quality, Department of Emergency Services, and local volunteer fire fighters to GPS locate fire hydrants
- Completed GIS upgrade to ArcGIS v.10.2

- City of Annapolis Cultural Resource Mitigation Plan
- The CRHMP addresses a number of natural and man-made threats, but the most concentrated planning effort is on the threat associated with sea level rise and flooding. The project is intended to engage Annapolis residents, business owners, property owners and local, state and federal agencies & public officials in the development of a hazard mitigation plan and implementation strategy.

City of Laurel

- Laurel is about to launch a 'My Laurel' mobile app which will feature a number of widgets including a Walking Tour of historic sites built using ESRI's Story Board template. It's still being finalized although it is publicly viewable now on AGOL, it's just not advertised. It was collaboration with Laurel's Historical Society who provided most of the content including historic images.
