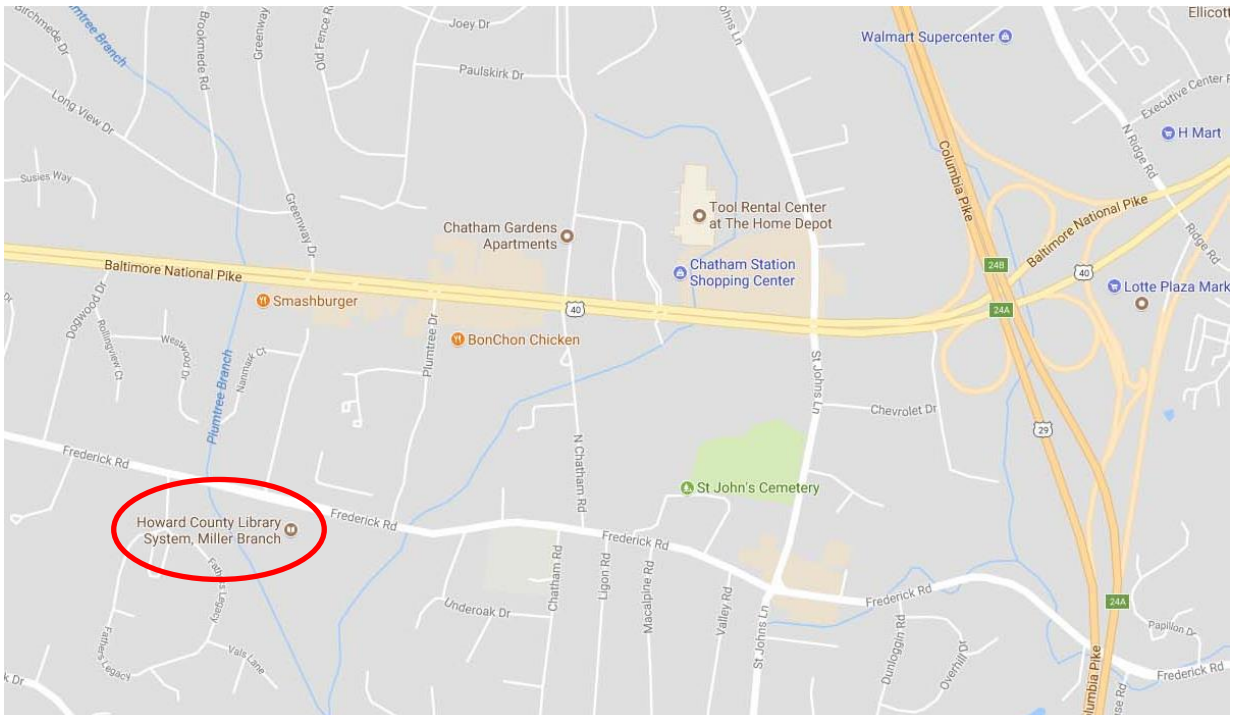

Directions:

- Frederick and West: Interstate 70 East to U.S. 40 (Exit 82). Follow U.S. 40 3 miles and turn right on Frederick Road. Travel 1.5 miles on Frederick Road and the Miller Branch Library will be on the right.
- Baltimore Beltway (I-695), North and East: Exit Baltimore Beltway West onto Interstate 70 (Exit 16). Follow Interstate 70 about 4 miles to the Left Exit 87A onto U.S. 29 south toward Columbia. Travel about 1.5 miles south and exit on U.S 40 west (Exit 24B). Travel about ¼ mile west on U.S 40 to the traffic light at St. Johns Lane. Turn left on St. Johns Lane and follow it until Frederick Road. Turn right onto Frederick Road. Travel ½ mile and the Miller Branch Library will be on your left.
- Interstate 95 and South: Take Interstate 95 North until MD 100 and exit on MD 100 west toward Ellicott City (Exit 43B). Travel about 5 miles on MD 100 and exit onto U.S 29 toward Interstate 70 heading north. Travel U.S. 29 about 1.5 miles and exit onto U.S. 40 west (Exit 24B). Travel about ¼ mile west on U.S 40 to the traffic light at St. Johns Lane. Turn left on St. Johns Lane and follow it until Frederick Road. Turn right onto Frederick Road. Travel ½ mile and the Miller Branch Library will be on your left.
