Specific & local targeted strategy Strong local leadership & partners – multiple agencies


Multi-year investment strategy – supported by various State agencies



Sustainable Communities - Overview


2010 Sustainable Communities Act:

- Create a shared designation, "Sustainable Communities" among various agencies
- Consolidated past CL and DN designations
- All TOD and BRAC zones are Sustainable Communities

Sustainable Communities - MD

Sustainable Communities are places where public and private investments and partnerships achieve:


- 1. Development of a <u>healthy local economy</u>;
- 2. Protection and appreciation of <u>historical and cultural</u> resources;
- 3. A mix of land uses;
- 4. Affordable and sustainable housing and employment options;
- 5. Growth and development practices that protect the environment and conserve air, water and energy resources, encourage walkability and recreational opportunities, and where available, create access to transit.



GIS Applications: DHCD Mapper (Public)

- Allows users to verify if an address falls in a Sustainable Communities or any other DHCD revitalization area
- Allows users to see what a given area was designated prior to a Sustainable Community (legacy data).








