MSGIC Treasury Report - Al Wainger

Al—Sent a check to UMD for the intern in December; they never cashed it, so it came back in on the income side. A new check was written on 3/30.  - Membee Update (this is intermingled above as well)
 - Marshall—how does a new person sign up? Shawn—the admin of the org has to add the person to the org through the profile.

 - For Ashley—we need to tighten the process for adding, removing and where postings should be on the site. Niki will follow up with Ashley about this.

Following the big NG 911 Meeting at the end of February, a group discussion was set up on Google for comments on the NENA Model. There has been no feedback on the group discussion so Peter will have to follow up and see if we can get movement.
 - o Maryland Elevation Working Group Erin Silva (Roger Barlow)
 - Roger—NOAA near shore topo bathymetric data gathering is underway with several projects. NOAA data will be posted on digital coast as LAS files. Will be similar quality to QL 2 land lidar.
 - Project occurring in Annapolis with the Naval Academy. Naval Academy Facilities group is doing studies to increase flood protection on the campus.
 - Big activity is 3D Nation that is a study and survey going on for all elevation data (land and bathymetric.). Joint survey between USGS and NOAA. Dewberry is the selected contractor. Rich Ort is the state champion and will be selecting the groups that are participating. Looking for a max of 15 participants that use lidar on a regular basis. Kick off meeting was 3/23/18. This is a nationwide study, so it is a large group. Waiting on OMB approval to get started. Once approved, it will take 3-

4 weeks for the survey to be completed. There will be a workshop at a later time to clarify the mission areas with the respondents. May tie into the elevation work group and TUgis.
