

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KEYS TO A SUCCESSFUL REMOTE INTERVIEW


- Preparation
- Interview
- Follow Up



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PREPARATION

- Pick the time/place
- Research the company
- Know who is interviewing you
- Look over the job description
- Send your portfolio in advance






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PREPARATION: DAY BEFORE THE INTERVIEW

- Confirm the time
- Resume, skill list, portfolio ready to go
- Check your technology
- Consider answers to possible questions
- Double check your space
- Prep your attire





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INTERVIEW DAY

- Start strong
- Smile
- Create a conversation
- Take notes
- Concluding your interview





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INTERVIEW: THE QUESTIONS

General:

- Tell us about a time you were faced with a problem, how did you solve it, and what was the result? What did you learn from it?
 - Describe your ideal manager.

Emerging Professionals:

- Why did you choose a GIS career?
- Do you know any programing languages?
- Give an elevator pitch on why our organization needs your GIS skills.
- Tell us about how you organize, plan, and prioritize your work.

A few years in the field:

- How proficient are you with the programming/scripting language JavaScript? Please tell us about how you have used it in your work.
- This organization works on projects in a group and individually. How do you communicate to keep everyone on your team informed?



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FOLLOW UP

- The thank-you email
- Follow up





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LAST MINUTE THOUGHTS

- Interviewing someone remotely is stressful for everyone
- Interviewing are necessary but can be very time consuming for the hiring manager
- They may ask you to take a skills test at one of their facilities
- If they ask for references make sure your references know that you will be using them
