

Presentation: State Caucus Update







Maryland Department of Commerce (MDC)

MDC continues to use GIS to map Enterprise Zones and RISE (Regional Institution Strategic Enterprise) Zones which are specific areas entitled to real and income tax property incentives. When MDC receives an application to designate a specific area, they partner with DoIT and the GIS representatives from the counties to determine the size, boundaries and eligibility of the area.

MDC utilizes PFA, DHCH sustainable community and opportunity zone maps to determine if a business is eligible for place-base tax incentives. These tools are utilized by the tax group as well as MDC internal business representatives and business community at large.





Parcel points and polygons are now updated with Assessments' data fields every other month and made available for download statewide (gdb) and by county/Baltimore City (shp). These downloads contain the same geometry as found in *MdProperty View* and *FINDER* Quantum, though sometimes the geometry is available in these downloads a few weeks ahead of *MdProperty View* and *FINDER* Quantum production.



The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) is responsible for building, operating, and maintaining a safe and seamless multi-modal transportation network. To accomplish this, the Maryland Transportation Plan (MTP) establishes a 20-year vision through a series of Statewide goals and objectives. To track MDOT's progress on meeting these goals and objectives, MDOT publishes an annual Attainment Report on Transportation System Performance (AR) to identify successes, challenges, and strategies for improving the transportation services delivered to Maryland residents.
