- HB 684 Still showing a status of at the Governor's office: http://mgaleg.maryland.gov/mgawebsite/Legislation/Details/HB0684
- There is a similar bill in Pennsylvania that might have impacts.
 - Similar to Maryland
 - Came from a case where a company was hired to perform an asset inventory collecting GPS points in the field. The license board originally ruled that the company was performing services without a license, but it was eventually overturned.
- Key terms discussed that require "legal documents" and "authoritative"
- Logan recommended that someone pull together a presentation on how this impacts the industry
- Roger recommended that we should have somebody attend the MSS meetings, or review minutes.
- There was also a general recommendation that we should be more proactive when these bills come up including testifying on behalf of the GIS industry, sending out letters to lawmakers/Governor, and/or eliciting feedback from the community.
