MSGIC Treasury Report – Jen Chadwick-Moore

- IRS Status Update
 - Haven't heard anything back from Patty or the IRS
- Credit Card
 - Whomever is on the card would be liable for any issues with fraud or debt.
 - Charity Charge - organization that supplies organization's with credit cards without the personal liability. They require a deposit that covers your expected annual expenditure. After the first year, they give you credit and it would work like a normal credit card
