Delmarva Conference - May 12th - May 14th, 2022

- MSGIC was set to have a booth for the 2020 conference which was canceled

Maryland Elevation Working Group – Erin Silva & Roger Barlow

- Topographic Lidar for Allegeny, Washington, and Frederick counties was collected by USGS 3DEP contractor in December 2021. Data delivery should be in about a year. This data was funded by USGS in support of Chesapeake Bay Ecosystem Science activities.
- The above activity meshes well with the October 2021 topo/bathy collection for the Potomac River reach from Shepherdstown, WV to Hancock, MD. This data is in processing, pilot areas are being worked out now. Delivery to USGS and ICPRB expected in July 2022. USGS is formulating an estimate for the next upstream reach from Hancock, MD to Paw Paw, WV.
- Elevation Work Group is looking to meet in February-March to discuss the potential for a Broad Agency Announcement proposal for 3DEP lidar, possibly Dorchester, Caroline, Talbot counties.

Geospatial Career Outreach Working Group – Christina Gladmon

- No updates

- EPA announcement: public access is migrating, scheduled to be completed Jan 13 (impacts login for users of EPA geospatial data)

- LiDAR processing for Anne Arundel is just about ready to be made public
- Meeting with ESRDC to discuss getting LiDAR derivative products for MoCo and PG County (end of May/June) – QL1 data
- New testing sites are being added daily to coronavirus site
