New Topics & Open/General Discussion

Unfunded GIS Position at Maryland Department of Emergency Management (Peter Hanna)

- The GIS positions at MDEM are not funded and not being filled. This is an important job and most if not all other state emergency management organizations have this position. Joanie Appell from Anne Arundel County is asking that MSGIC send an open letter to the State of Maryland on the importance of this position and the impact of leaving it unfilled.
- There is at least one GIS person at MDEM, but it is unclear what their role is. Joanie should articulate what is lacking so that MDEM can respond as to whether they have someone who is supposed to be attending to those responsibilities.

Update from Maryland's Chief Data Officer (Pat McLoughlin)

GISCI Announces GISP Endorsement Designation (Harrison Bloom)

Strategic Goals - Niki Miller

- No change in goals for the 2021/2022 year since the last meeting
- Asked members of the executive committee to make an effort to reach out to underrepresented groups to get them more involved in MSGIC by participating in executive committee meetings and working groups, giving presentations at quarterlies, and providing instruction for upcoming trainings

Training - Ryan Mello

- TUGis Training Series
 - There will not be a dedicated day of training at TUGis this year due to the cost, and Towson asked MSGIC if they would offer training outside of TUGis
 - The Training Subcommittee has been meeting to prepare for the launch of the TUGis Training Series
 - Create website content
 - Prepare email announcement
 - Set up calendar events
 - Figure out registration for members vs. non-members
 - Training sessions will occur from April to August and will be free to members
 - Non-members will pay a \$50 fee for one training session and they will receive a free 1-year membership (June 2022 to June 2023)

- Payment
 - Will pay trainers \$100/hour, which aligns with payment for past MSGIC training sessions
 - In the past, Towson paid trainers for an hour of prep time, so 3-hour trainings would cost \$400 total; 6-hour trainings would cost \$700 total (\$600 course + \$100 prep), etc.
 - Shorter trainings may be low or now cost
 - We may be able to reduce our TUgis contribution since we are hosting the training series; Niki and Shawn have a meeting scheduled with Towson later this week to discuss

Membership Year
